



Travel Visa Information

We recommend starting your registration and visa process early. Consult with the Canadian Embassy in your country and their website for their current visa application requirements. When applying for your Visa, include evidence of previous trips to Canada and include proof of intent of returning to your country. Apply for your visa with all required documents.

To facilitate your visit, contact the Trade Officer at the Canadian Consulate office in your country to discuss potential trade mission opportunities.

If your visa application requires more than 6 weeks, please note we will require up to 10 days to process the Letter of Invitation in a timely manner. Do not travel to Canada, or make travel arrangements, without proper entry documentation.
